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Making your first phone call

- a. If your screen is off, press Phone/Send to turn on the phone and wake up the screen. If the Keyguard is on, press Center.
- b. To send and receive calls, your phone must be connected to the network. If it is connected, the network status icon _____ will appear at the top of the screen. If the icon does not appear, press and hold Power/End . You will hear a series of ascending tones as the phone begins a network search.
- c. Using the number pad on the keyboard, enter the desired phone number
- d. Press Phone/Send \$\ to dial.
- e. When your call is complete, press Power/End on to hang up.
- ✓ Use the Volume button on the side of your phone to adjust your call volume.

Setting up your E-mail in VersaMail

- a. Go to Applications and select VersaMail
- b. Open the menus
- c. Select Accounts, then Account Setup
- d. Select New.
- e. In the Account Setup screen, complete the following fields:
- Account Name, enter a descriptive name
- Mail Service, from the dropdown menu, select your e-mail provider or Other if your provider is not listed.
- If you chose **Other**, in the **Protocol** dropdown menu select POP, IMAP or Exchange ActiveSync. (Check with your e-mail service provider to find the protocol for your e-mail account.)
- f. Click Next
- g. Enter your Username and Password and select OK.
- h. Click Next.
- i. Verify your E-mail Address and complete the following fields:
- Incoming Mail Server, this field will be pre-populated if your Mail Service was selected from the dropdown menu, otherwise check with your e-mail service pro-
- Outgoing Mail Server, this field will be pre-populated if your Mail Service was selected from the dropdown menu, otherwise type mail.1xbell.ca
- k. Click Done.
- ✓ To access symbols or accents, enter the character that corresponds to your desired symbol or accent, press the ALT key and then use the Up or Down arrows to highlight the desired





Installing your Treo Battery

- a. Press the release button and slide the batters
- b. Align the metal contacts on the battery with the metal contacts in the hattery compartment and then insert the battery at a 45-degree angle


Using the Camera


